The David Adamany – WSU Alumni Association Endowed Scholarship



Introduction

The Wayne State University Alumni Association strives to increase opportunities for students, many of whom are the first in their families to pursue a college degree. By offering scholarships to student leaders, the alumni association recognizes the important contributions of student activities both to the student's educational experience and to campus life. Through this scholarship program, the alumni association encourages the student leaders of today to become the alumni leaders of tomorrow, and pays tribute to President Emeritus David Adamany, who served from 1982 to 1997.

Awards

Awards are for tuition only for full- or part-time study at Wayne State University (maximum 12 credit hours per semester) in the fall and winter semesters. Funds are for undergraduate study only and are not available for students enrolled at the post-bachelor level or pursuing a second bachelor's degree. See criteria for complete requirements.

The Application Process

To apply for a David Adamany-WSU Alumni Association Endowed Scholarship, you must:

1. Complete and submit the attached application to the WSU Alumni Association (Alumni House, 441 Gilmour Mall, Detroit, MI 48202) no later than March 30, 2016 5:00 pm.
 - A. The two letters of recommendation must be dated no earlier than August 2015. The letters should be written by WSU faculty, staff or students, who are extremely familiar with the scope and depth of your extracurricular activities. The relationship between the recommender and the applicant should be explained.
 - B. A copy of your most recent academic transcript from WSU.

NOTE: Submit all materials as one package. Transcripts and letters must be attached to the completed application form. They will not be accepted separately.

2. Have at least a 2.75 grade point average at the time of application.

NOTE: Late, incomplete, or faxed applications will not be accepted. Only two letters of recommendation will be read and it is suggested that the applicant explain the recommendation guidelines to the recommender. Applicants are responsible for ensuring that applications are received by the deadline.

Criteria for Scholarships

The criteria for the David Adamany-WSU Alumni Association Endowed Scholarship include:

1. Minimum grade point average of 2.75 at time of application.
2. Sophomore status or above for the fall 2016 semester.
3. Michigan residency.
4. Quality of recommendation letters.
5. Content of the application.

Note: you must complete all parts of the application to be considered for this scholarship. Submit only the information requested. Additional materials will not be considered.

The Selection Process

This is a competitive scholarship. Recipients are selected by the Alumni Association Scholarship Committee. The committee ranks the applicants on the basis of the stated criteria. Applicants ranked highest are awarded scholarships. Availability of funds limits the number of scholarships awarded.

Application Requirements

All documents must be attached to the application upon submission. Faxed, late, or incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. Attach copies of your most recent WSU academic transcript that must include your most recent semester. Applicants must have a minimum 2.75 grade point average at time of application. Pipeline print outs are acceptable.
2. Attach two current letters of recommendation (dated no earlier than August 2015) from individuals who are familiar with your WSU extracurricular activities and leadership experience.

Scholarship recipients are selected based on their application, scope of university activities, quality of recommendations and personal statement. On the basis of these criteria, all applicants are ranked by the Alumni Association Scholarship Committee.
