Taylor A. Lewis, M.D. and Cleveland Hurst III shared a special bond of friendship. Hurst graduated from Wayne State in '71 and Dr. Lewis graduated in '78. Both served on the Wayne State Alumni Association Board of **Directors and Executive** Committee. Dr. Lewis also served as president and he never forgot his obligation to lend a hand. Dr. Lewis established the Taylor A. Lewis, M.D. and Cleveland Hurst III Endowed Scholarship to provide financial assistance, to recognize scholastic achievement, to encourage continued progress and to provide assistance to students in financing their education at Wayne State University.

#### **Awards**

The \$1,000 scholarship provides financial assistance to those who wish to return to school after a postponement, either following graduation from high school or during their post-secondary education. Awards may be used for Wayne State tuition and educational expenses. Recipients may not receive this award more than once.

- 5. Attach two recommendation letters and Authorization to Release Records to the completed application and submit all material as one package by <u>March 30, 5:00 p.m.</u> to the address noted below. Material will not be accepted separately, late or incomplete.

6. Recipients are selected by the WSU Alumni Association. Awards will be made based on the Evaluation Criteria. Availability of funds limits the number of awards. Awards will be distributed by the WSU Office of Student Financial Aid according to university policies and procedures.

## **Qualifying Criteria**

- 1. Currently enrolled or newly accepted full-time or part-time undergraduate Wayne State student.
- 2. No previous awards from the Taylor A. Lewis, M.D. and Cleveland Hurst III Endowed Scholarship.
- 3. Postponement of post-secondary education (see Evaluation Criteria).

#### **Evaluation Criteria**

- 1. First consideration shall be given to students who have delayed attending college after high school graduation and students who are returning to the university after an extended absence.
- 2. Demonstrated financial need.
- 3. Recommendation letters.
- 4. Response to application questions.
